CODE OF CONDUCT

To further our use and enjoyment of the Village Club and to maintain our family-friendly environment, anyone using the Village Club facilities must treat members, guests, employees, and property with courtesy and respect. Conduct that is offensive or unsafe is strictly prohibited.

Members are responsible for the conduct of their family, dependent children, and guests. A member or a member's guest who engages in offensive or unsafe conduct (1) may be asked to leave the premises; and (2) may be reprimanded or temporarily suspended from using the club facilities by the Village Club general manager, after consultation with other managers and available board members. Depending upon the nature of the conduct, the length of the offender's suspension can last from one day until the next board meeting. The Village Club board will be promptly notified of any violation of the code of conduct and will review the incident at its next meeting. At the next board meeting, the member may be reprimanded, suspended, or expelled by the Village Club board of directors under Article VII of the By-laws. All members may address any grievances regarding discipline imposed under the code of conduct at a monthly Board meeting.

These rules are made for the ultimate safety and enjoyment of Village Club members and their guests.
